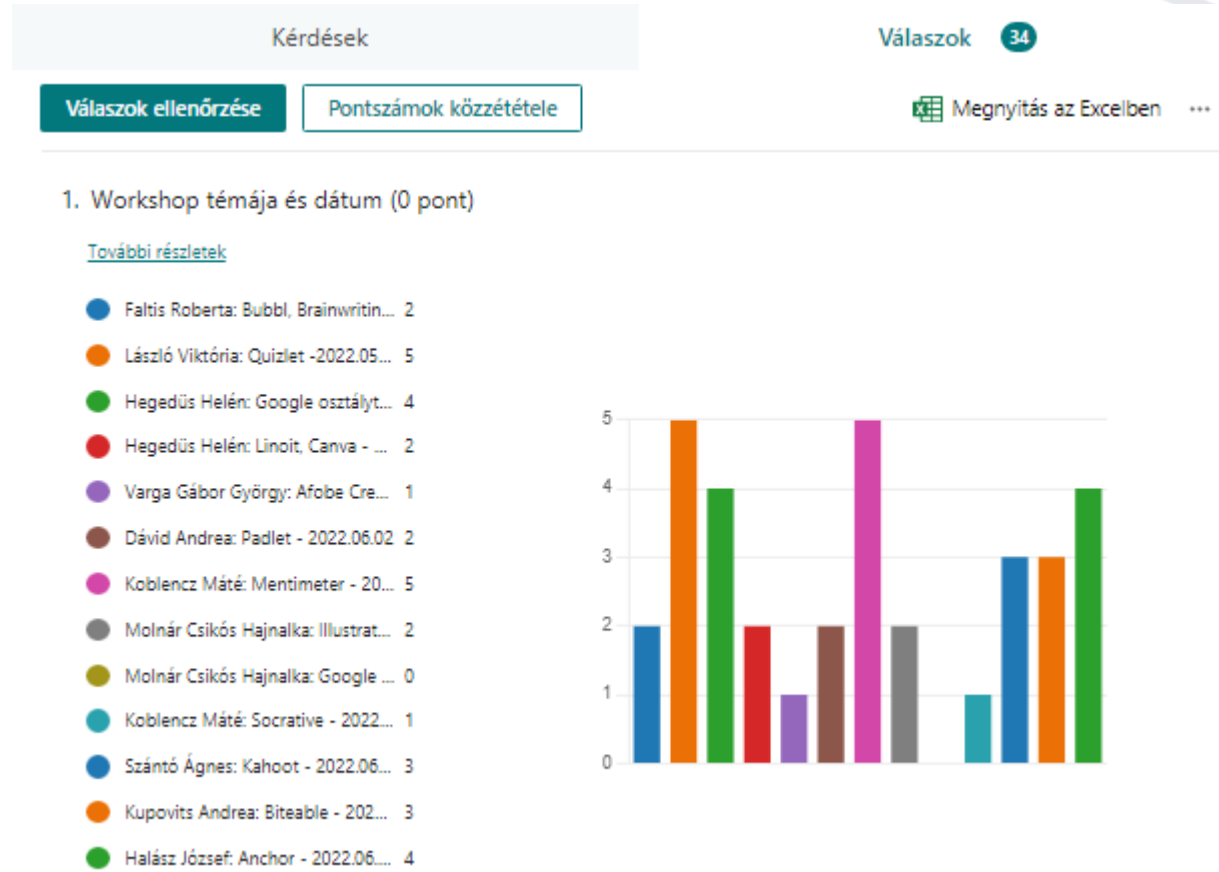

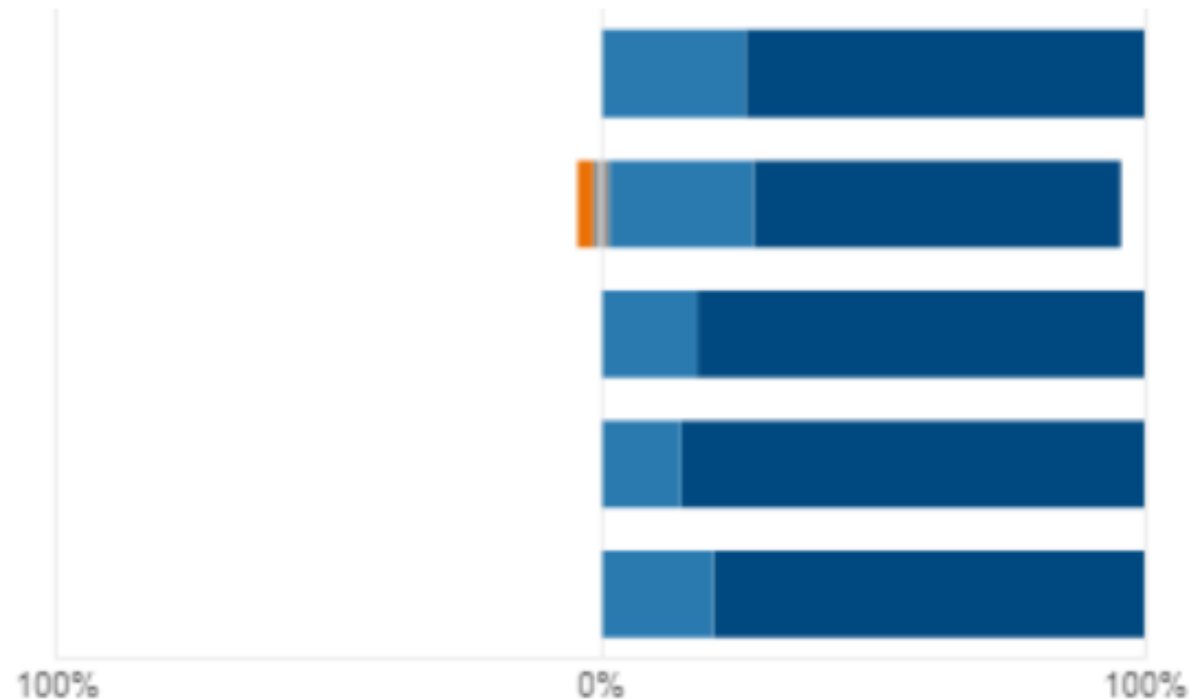

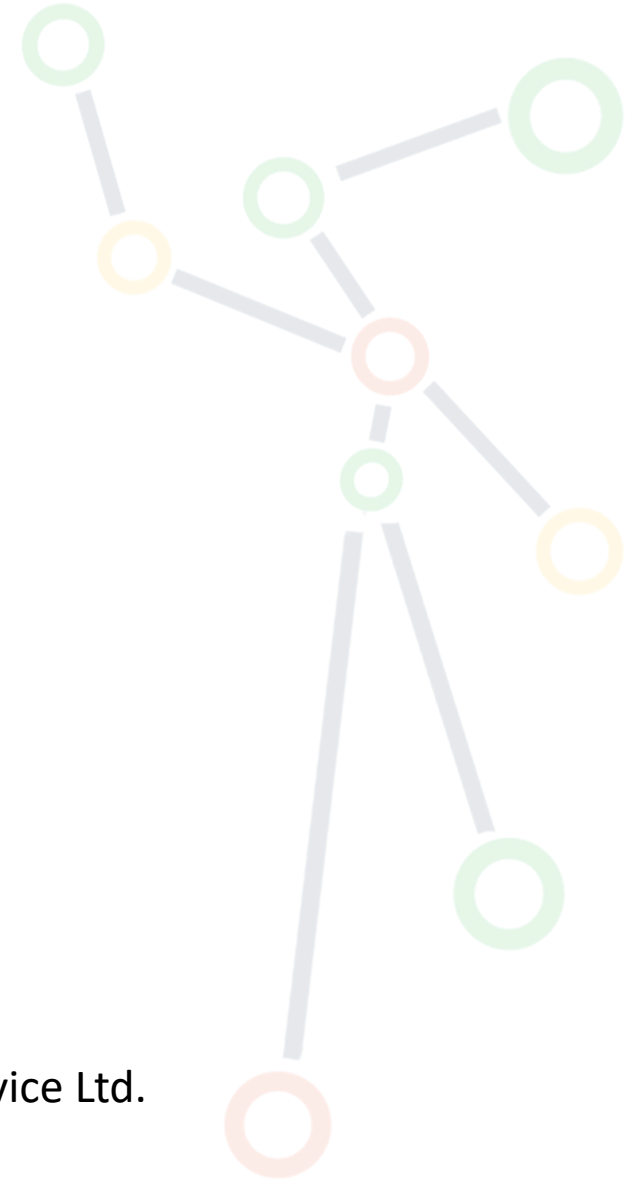


# DMC/Workshops/Digital lessons – Experiences/Conclusions
